I've discussed this issue with my supervisor (Mike Radecki) and we don't see any problem using the JAN marking on these parts as they still meet the requirements of the spec. However, we do have a concern. If these parts are being purchased for military use, parts purchased for replacement purposes may or may not meet the requirements of the original purchase order clause. A situation like this would normallybe handled with a "selected item drawing" with a unique part number. We would be willing to draft a drawing if there was a reasonable justification for this requirement.
